



## Series Overview

Series Name	Product Description
<b>Psalms</b>	The Worthy series is designed to invite us to adjust our focus away from ourselves, and our myopic tendencies and to experience a personal, intimate relationship with God. Students will have the opportunity to own their faith as they bring honest details of their lives to God—who can powerfully transform them.
<b>Ephesians</b>	The Ephesians series empowers students to own their faith as they seek and respond to God, finding their identity in Him. Students will journey through Ephesians as they look upward to discover who God is, inward to form their identity in Him, and outward to worship in response.
<b>Mark</b>	The Mark series encourages students to ask this question: Who is Jesus Christ? Through this gospel-centered series, students will observe Jesus up close and personally as they dig into Mark’s gospel and discover for themselves who Jesus really is, what He really said, and why He still is, to this day, our promised King and personal Savior.
<b>Genesis</b>	The Genesis series introduces students to the first book of God’s grand redemptive narrative. Genesis is not presented as a collection of Sunday school stories, but as the beginning of one continuous epic story line of a redeeming, loving God. Students will embark on a journey to discover for themselves how God intended relationships to function and how He continues to use broken people and families to bring Himself glory.
<b>Judges</b>	The Judges series shows students that God is on a mission to gather a community of worshippers for Himself. From the book of Judges, students will learn that God is the ultimate hero and He uses imperfect people, flaws and all, to fulfill His plan to redeem the world.
<b>Acts</b>	The Acts series nurtures an understanding of God’s grand redemptive narrative—which continues to this day through the power of the Holy Spirit building, empowering, and sending His Church—and helps students find their place in it.
<b>Advent (5 weeks)</b>	Through the lens of the familiar Christmas story, this five-week miniseries focuses on the traditional virtues of Advent—hope, peace, joy, and love. Students will celebrate and anticipate the arrival of Jesus Christ our Savior as they discover the beauty embedded within the Christmas story—as we wait together, patiently, expectantly, and intentionally, we’re conformed to the image of the One for whom we wait.
